



HOW MANY PEOPLE BECOME JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES?

According to the Watchtower's 2006 Worldwide Report in just 1 year (2005-2006), the Watchtower organization added 248,327 members. Now, this doesn't necessarily translate to "newbies"; this number can also refer to those in the Watchtower organization who decide to become baptized and be officially recognized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses after attending their meetings for years.

But let's just say (and this is a very conservative figure) that 50% of these are "newbies," individuals from other faiths who received a knock on the door from Jehovah's Witnesses sometime that year. Fifty percent of 248,327 = 124,164 NEW members in 2005-2006.

This means approximately 340 people *per day* are becoming Jehovah's Witnesses.

My mother was a Methodist Sunday school teacher when she became a Jehovah's Witnesses and dumped her Christian faith and all of our "non-believing" relatives. This leads me to wonder:

**How many of these 124,164
will be leaving *your* church *this* year?**
